Membership Participation Points Proposal

Fall 2010/Winter 2011

- **Total Needed:**
 - To be considered “in good standing”, member must earn 10 points by the end of each Winter school semester (late April)
- **Chapter Meetings**
 - Two meetings each month (4 per semester – 8 per year)
 - Earn 1 point for each meeting attended
 - Because the meetings are considered to be identical, members can only earn 1 point for one of the two meetings each month
 - Attendance will be taken at the end of each meeting
 - Pieces of paper will be handed out to members when they arrive at the meeting. Members will write their names, 6-digit ID and/or email on the paper and turn it in to one of the officers at the end of the meeting
- **Ways to Earn Points**
 - 1 point for every 1 hour of service through an NSCS sponsored event
 - May also earn 1 Point for every \$10 donated to an NSCS event
 - Only 2 points per event can be earned this way
 - Outside volunteer events
 - May submit “Points Request Form” to earn points for participation in events sponsored by other WSU organizations or by independent volunteer activities
 - Only 2 points per semester may be earned in this way
- **Incentives**
 - KAPLAN Prep Course Scholarship
 - Given to the member with the most points by the end of March
 - NSCS Scholarship
 - Given to the member with the 2nd most points by the end of March
 - Discount to NSCS Sponsored group event
 - Pistons game, Movie night, etc.
 - Exact prices and discounts to be decided by each year’s executive officers and advisor
 - Certificate of Active Membership given to all members who receive 10+ points by early April of each year
