#### **1. Greetings/ Ice Breaker:**

#### **2. Active Membership Reminder:**

- American Red Cross Blood Drive
  - **When:** November 17<sup>th</sup>
  - **Where:** Student Center
  - **Time:** 10:30-6:00p.m.
  - 6 volunteers are need per hour.
  - Volunteers will cover the registration table, canteen table, and will be recruiting donors.
  - You will earn **1 point** for an hour of volunteering and an additional **0.5 point** for wearing your NSCS t-shirt.
- Gleaners Canned Food Drive
  - **When:** November 3-19<sup>th</sup> at 5:00 p.m.
  - You can help by donating food items! Gleaners is in need of non-perishable food items (cans preferred but boxes accepted as well).
  - There will be boxes located in the following buildings on campus: UGL (entryway), State Hall (outside of study room), Old main (front entrance), Mort Harris Recreation, Fitness center (entryway), Student Center (south entrance).
  - When donating please put items in a bag with **your name and access ID** on a paper **INSIDE** the bag.
  - You will earn **1 point** for every **5 cans** you donate (with a maximum of 5 points).
  - Members are needed to help collect the food items from the boxes, and take them to the student center. Volunteers will be assigned to each building. Volunteers are needed for **Thursday, November**

**19th at 5 pm** for collection of the cans and sorting. You will receive **1 point** per hour of volunteering for helping us collect and sort the cans.
