1. Greetings/ Ice Breaker:

- Welcome back returning members and for the new members, congratulations on becoming part of this organization. Take the time to introduce yourself and get to know other members. 2. Leadership Opportunities/ Chairing Events:

Chairpersons will help the board member plan events, type up emails, communicate with members, set up, etc. *These positions are available for the entire duration of the semester.*

- Here are a few requirements when you chair an event:
 - The Chairperson has to be physically present at the event
 - The individual must print and bring in a sign in sheet with them as well make sure every member who attended that event signed in properly
 - The individual should scan/take a clear picture of the sign in sheet and email it to the board member
 - Finally, the individual has to take at least 10 pictures at the event
 - **For effectively chairing with these board members, the NSCS member will receive 6 points!!!**

3. Active Member Status: You can earn points throughout the school year by participating in events. In the end, those who earn a minimum of 20 points at the end of the school year will be awarded “Active Member” status – recognized by a certificate and party at the end.

- **How to earn points:** The number of hours you participate denotes the number of points you receive: Each meeting (once a month) is one point, every hour of service is worth one point.

- **Bonus points:** wearing your NSCS shirt for ANY event (including meetings!) earns you an extra 0.5 point. Also, taking a picture of yourself or other members at an event and emailing it to us earns you 0.5points for 5 pictures!
